BURSARY POLICY

INTRODUCTION

The School has limited resources from which it can offer Bursaries. We view a diverse pupil population as a key component of a full and balanced education and within the limits of our resources, strive to make the school affordable to as many families as we can. Our Bursary policy is focused on supporting two key aspects of our school ethos – our status as a Christian Faith School and our sense of school family values.

In line with our philosophy we offer the opportunity to apply for bursaries to the following:

1. Children of a member of the Christian Clergy.
2. Children of members of Staff
3. Sibling Discount Scheme

ELIGIBILITY

All parents/guardians whose children qualify under one of the above categories are eligible to apply for a Bursary and may contact the Bursar for more information.

PROCEDURE

Bursaries may be made available to parents/guardians of children entering any year group. They are awarded at the discretion of the Headmistress, Bursar and Chair of the General Purposes and Finance Committee.

Bursaries will be reviewed annually.

The School respects the confidentiality of the Bursary awards made to families and recipients are expected to do likewise.
