

# Coworth-Flexlands School Raises £6,123 for Daisy's Dream

On Monday 14 June 2010, Coworth-Flexlands School handed over a cheque for just over £6,123 to the local charity Daisy's Dream.

The money was primarily raised at a bi-annual charity Ball and Auction organised by the School's Social Committee. Attended by over 180 parents and friends of the School, the event was held at Wentworth Golf Club in Surrey in May. Similar events are organised every two years by Coworth-Flexlands School to raise money for local charities. Additional funds were raised by the children at other events held at the school during the year.

Daisy's Dream supports children and their families both facing and following bereavement throughout the local area. Each year they support over 500 children trying to cope with the death of a parent, brother, sister, or other close relative providing a tailored service to meet the needs of each individual. Each year they need to raise £200,000 to maintain and develop this service.
