

COWORTH-FLEXLANDS LAUNCHES NEW 'SKYLARK NURSERY'

On Friday 17 June, Coworth-Flexlands School launched its new 'Skylark Nursery'.

Three of the school's 'Year Six girls' - Elana, Paige and Jessica – who all started at Coworth-Flexlands in the Nursery, helped Mrs. Sweeney to cut the ribbon. The Nursery children showed off the Skylarks that they had made for the occasion before tucking into specially prepared Skylark cupcakes.

The launch follows a year of redevelopment of the original facilities providing even greater indoor and outdoor space to meet the growing local demand for early years places. In addition to the introduction of flexible nursery sessions and extended day options, Coworth-Flexlands has invested in an outdoor classroom and a 'Woodland Walk' for outdoor learning and exploration. Along with a new dedicated Skylark Nursery playground - with a tree-house, a fitness trail, exploration tables and a log cabin - the indoor classrooms have also been re-developed; creating more space and improved resources for play and learning across all areas of the EYFS curriculum.

"The changes we have made to both our indoor and outdoor space will allow our very youngest children to play and learn in the best possible environment", explains Headmistress, Mrs Anne Sweeney. "Spending time outdoors has such a positive impact on a child's sense of well-being supporting all aspects of a child's development. With over 13 acres of beautiful grounds we are in the fortunate position of being able to make this happen."

Coworth-Flexlands School is an independent preparatory day school. Located on the outskirts of Chobham Common, the School is non-selective yet achieves strong and consistent academic results. This year all Year 6 girls secured places at their chosen schools with one third winning scholarships and awards to leading independent secondary schools.
